## White Hawk Country Club's Silver Hawk Debuts This Golf Season

White Hawk Country Club, Northwest Indiana's premier golf facility, is set to open its fourth nine: *Silver Hawk*. With the opening of Silver Hawk this golf season, White Hawk Country Club will be Northwest Indiana's *only* 36-hole golf course.

The original 18 holes opened to rave reviews in 1996, as a demanding yet fair test for any golfer. The course's esteemed architect, Nugent & Associates, was called upon once more in 1999, when an adjacent tract of land was acquired for the resulting nine, known as Black Hawk.

In the summer of 2006, the addition of Silver Hawk will make White Hawk Country Club Northwest Indiana's first and *only* 36-hole course. Silver Hawk will measure an impressive 3,800 yards. This brings an 18-hole total of well over 7,300 yards when combined with any of the other nines. Silver Hawk's monstrous par five measures over 640 yards. A string of par fours weaves through the wetlands and along the water at an average of 450 yards a piece, accounting for a huge chunk of the overall yardage. Fifty-one bunkers peppered throughout the course add to the length of Silver Hawk.

This amazing combination will make White Hawk Country Club home to one of the longest 9-hole courses in the state of Indiana. Architect Nugent & Associates has been quoted as saying, "... this is the hardest string of holes that I have ever put together." One thing is certain, with this addition White Hawk will not only be Northwest Indiana's premier golf facility, but one of the nation's.
