While the Village Links of Glen Ellyn has been around since 1967, the addition of a new restaurant, bar, banquet and meeting room for 2013 completes a total makeover for this favorite west suburban course.

The new amenities make the Village Links a great choice for upscale golf outings and business meetings. The 150 seat banquet room can host outings and non-golf gatherings. A new Board Room is equipped with the latest audio/visual gear for groups up to 30 wanting to conduct business before or after golf.

The Village Links' location at the intersection of I-88 and I-355 makes it one of the metro area's most accessible courses, convenient to the Loop, O'Hare, Schaumburg, Oak Brook, and the I-294 corridor.

The Village Links has long been recognized as a championship golf course having hosted 25 Western Open Qualifyings and scores of qualifiers for national USGA championships. Last year they hosted the U.S. Open Sectional Qualifying for the fifth time.



Regardless of the number of guests, everyone will be treated to gracious food and drink, hospitality, and spectacular views of the rolling 240 acre property that was the first public golf course in the world to be certified as a wildlife sanctuary by Audubon International.

The course was completely renovated in 2004, rebuilding every tee, green, fairway and bunker while retaining the essence of the original layout. This latest upgrade, which in addition to the expanded clubhouse also includes an enlarged driving range, gives golfers something exciting to enjoy in 2013.
