The 2005 Solheim Cup will be played from Sept. 9-11 at the magnificent Crooked Stick Golf Club in Carmel, Indiana. Nancy Lopez hails as captain of the U. As the defending champion, the European Team needs 14 points in 2005 to retain the Cup, with the U.S. Team requiring 14-1/2 points to win the event.
